Primitive Dry Camping (no electric, water or septic available)

Sites have either hitching post or high ties, and non-potable water hydrants in campground

Trail riding all weekend with 30 miles of trails all accessible from the Horseman's Camp.

- **Friday night:** hot dog and chili meal with music entertainment by "The Hitchhikers" Celtic band.
- **Saturday:** try Helge Buflod's obstacle course to test your and your horse's ability, demonstrations, and special guests. Dinner at 5:30 PM with a great meal, speakers, Chinese auction, and entertainment by "The Hip-Shakin' Daddy's" rockabilly band from 6 PM to 8 PM.
- **Sunday morning:** Cowboy Church at 8 AM followed by a pay-as-you-go pancake breakfast in the shelter house.
